<p>Build a snow creation - take a picture and write a paragraph about what you have built.</p>	<p>Measure the depth of the snow with a ruler- create a table (you could do this on the computer) and keep track of the depth. Remember to always measure the same spot to make it a fair test!</p>	<p>Practice times tables/divisions on hit the button and complete individual tasks set on Sumdog (login details in blue diary).</p>	<p>Practice spelling words from red book by making them - you could use snow, playdough, lego or you could draw them in bubble letters/different colours.</p>
<p>List as many adjectives to describe winter as you can. Then see if you can combine them with each other and a noun to create a phrase e.g. sparkly, glistening snow.</p>	<p>Create an indoor aerobic routine to a piece of music - include a series of exercises. Then try out your routine a few times!</p>	<p>Find a paper folding/origami tutorial and follow it!</p>	<p>Watch newsround (google watch newsround), pick one of the news stories and write a paragraph summarising it - or giving your opinion on it.</p>
<p>Can you remember our connectives and homophones from our last set of board tasks? See if you can do a connective and a homophone sentence!</p>	<p>Create a piece of winter art - it could be a drawing, or you could use other materials you have at home such as a cotton wool snowman or painting.</p>	<p>Write a recount of your snow day. Remember an opening paragraph (who,what,where,when), time connectives (then, next, after) and a conclusion to sum it all up!</p>	<p>Create a cosy fort/nook/space and read your book in it. OR Read your book in the most unusual place in your house you can think of.</p>
